

INCEPTION

The origin of Banasthali is unique in more ways than one. Banasthali owes its existence neither to the zeal of an educationist, nor to that of a social reformer. It was established by the grieving parents of Shanta Bai with a view to provide the same kind of education to girls, that couldn't be provided to Shanta Bai due to her untimely demise. Starting out with just five students way back in 1935, today, Banasthali Vidyapith has become a premier institute in women's education, being hailed as 'World's largest fully residential women's university'. The Vidyapith boasts of having more than 15000 students on its campus, which is spread across more than 850 acres of land.

The fabric of education at the Vidyapith is based on the ideology of five-fold education comprising of physical, practical, aesthetic, intellectual and, above all, moral aspects for the holistic development of the students. The Vidyapith offers a variety of programmes from nursery up to doctoral level across a wide spectrum of disciplines to prepare enlightened citizens with a strong value-base.

Banasthali Vidyapith has been identified by various funding organizations including Government as well as Industries for setting up Centres of Excellence-

- 1. **State Bank of India School of Commerce and Banking:** State Bank of India has donated a generous philanthropic grant for promoting commerce and banking education.
- 2. **Centre for Mathematical Sciences:** DST provided Rs. 1.45 Crores to setup Centre for Mathematical Sciences to motivate research & development in thrust areas of Mathematical Sciences. There are only 3-4 such centres in the country.
- 3. **Jamnalal Bajaj School of Legal Studies:** Keeping in view the need for an All Women's Law School, the Bajaj Foundation has kindly consented to provide a one- time generous philanthropic grant.
- 4. **Banasthali Centre for Education and Research in Basic Sciences:** The DST has identified Vidyapith as a centre of CURIE (Consolidation of University Research for Innovation and Excellence in Women Universities) and granted Rs. 5.20 Crores to set up Banasthali Centre for Education and Research in Basic Sciences.
- 5. **IBM Centre of Excellence at Faculty of Computing and Mathematics** IBM, the tech giant, has established a centre of excellence at Faculty of Computing and Mathematics to acquaint students with emerging business trends and nurture industry ready skills for young brains.
- 6. **Centre for Research in MSME & Promotion of Entrepreneurship in Women**: To promote entrepreneurship and MSME training and research among women, the erstwhile SBBJ has generously donated to set up a centre for research in MSME for women.
- 7. **Atal Incubation Centre sponsored by NITI Aayog:** The NITI Aayog has partnered with Banasthali Vidyapith to set up an all women Atal Incubation Centre to nurture innovative business startups in their pursuit to become scalable and sustainable enterprises.



MBA AT BANASTHALI

Following are the main attractions of the MBA program:

Industry Meets Academia

The MBA program at Banasthali ensures continuous engagement of participants with industry professionals and organizations by way of guest lectures and live projects – keeping the participants abreast with upcoming trends in the corporate world.

Internships

As a part of the curriculum, each student takes up an internship for a period of 20-24 weeks, after the completion of the first year. This helps them gain industry exposure.











GRADUATION WISE DISTRIBUTION



MAJOR SPECIALIZATION-WISE DISTRIBUTION














MINOR SPECIALIZATION-WISE DISTRIBUTION



MAJOR SPECIALIZATIONS

FINANCE

Finance is one of the most popularly chosen specializations at WISDOM. This is evident from the fact that out of the current batch strength of 360, 180 have chosen it as a major while 45 have chosen it as a minor specialization. The course has been specially designed to help students analyze and examine critically the nuances of Finance and Fund Management, while simultaneously appreciating the overarching role Finance, as a stream, plays in the Business Organization.

MARKETING

Marketing, for a long time now, has been quite popular among the students, as an area of specialization. In the current batch 55 students have chosen marketing as their major specialization; while 158 have it as a minor specialization. Banasthali is known to be the institution that churns out a talented pool of managers who have consistently proved themselves by carving niche in the ever competitive, pulsating and exciting domain of Marketing.











HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT

The Human Resource Development is one of the core courses to be offered at WISDOM. In the current batch, a whopping 125 number of students have it as a major specialization while 55 have opted for HRM as a minor specialization. This course prepares the students to meet the employer's strategic objectives, because for the organization to function smoothly, the workforce needs to be managed properly.

AVIATION MANAGEMENT

Aviation management deals with the study of airlines, airports and businesses related to the aerospace industry. It also includes supervising routine operations undertaken by the ground staff of an airport or an organization in the aviation sector. All in all 42 students have picked Aviation Management as a major specialization.

MINOR SPECIALIZATION

In addition to the above areas of specialization, the university, keeping true to its quintessential philosophy of holistic development of students, also offers these courses as minor specializations:

CSR and Public Policy

This course helps to understand the dynamics of CSR and its role in the development of the organization while understanding the importance of social entrepreneurship and exploring avenues for bringing change in the society. This course has a total of 60 students who have opted for it.

Sports Management

Sports management is all about how to apply business and marketing techniques to the sports world and it also provides an overview of sports scenario in the country while preparing the students to manage sports events more efficiently and effectively.











KNOWLEDGE CREATION & DISSEMINATION

FACULTY - There is a three-tier faculty structure comprising of core, visiting and industry faculty. As on date, the FMS-WISDOM has 53 full time faculty members with average work experience of 12 years and average industry experience of 5 years. Many of the teachers have been conferred with awards for distinct teaching and innovation.

RESEARCH - During the last 23 years, 110 Ph.Ds. have been awarded at FMS-WISDOM, Banasthali Vidyapith, while, over 250 Research Papers in prominent journals have been published.
