About the Conference

Basic Biology provides an understanding about the living organisms and their interaction with the environment. The conference proposes to focus as to how the basic concepts in Biological Sciences have gradually matured and led to the emergence of their wide applications in human welfare. Consequently the last 3-4 decades saw how the understanding of the basic principles of modern biology laid the foundation for the rapid rise of Biotechnology as an industry which attracted entrepreneurs in India and across the globe. It is a prime sunrise industry of today with thousands of billions of dollars of investment and tremendous scope for future growth and expansion.

The main idea of the conference is to highlight and reemphasize the significance of Basic Biology. The conference would provide an exciting platform for discussions and exchange of scientific ideas amongst the participants — the young researchers as well as senior scientists — some of them may eventually lead to fruitful collaborations and new concepts. This conference would provide all the participants with ample opportunity to either contribute in the scientific sessions or attend a number of outstanding key messages and invited lectures.

About the Institute

Banasthali Vidyapith, world's largest residential women's university was founded by (Late) Smt. Ratan Shastri and (Late) Pandit Hira Lal Shastri on October 6, 1935 to fill the vacuum caused by the sudden demise of their highly talented and promising daughter Shantabai. On October 25, 1983 the Government of India, on the advice of University Grants Commission, New Delhi notified Banasthali as an Institution deemed to be University.

With a total strength of around 15,000 students, the Institution aims at the amalgamation of spiritual values and scientific achievements. The University has over 30 teaching departments. Specifications for Poster

Call for Papers:

The scientific programme committee invites you to submit abstracts for oral and poster presentations during different sessions of the conference. The abstract must be submitted electronically/ by post to the Organizing Secretary, email: ncbbcb2017@gmail.com. Prospective authors should submit an abstract (A4 size, text font size 12, Times New Roman, 1.5 line spacing) through email before September 30, 2017. The abstract should not exceed 300 words. The title of the abstract should by typed in font size 14. The complete postal addresses of the authors along with the email address of the corresponding author should be provided. The name of the presenting author should be underlined. It is proposed to publish proceedings of the conference containing a selected number of full papers. Full papers should be submitted before October 20, 2017.

Banasthali is located 72 km from the Pink City Jaipur, 8 km off on Jaipur-Kota Road. Frequent bus service is available for Banasthali University campus/ Newai from main Bus Stand (Sindhi Camp) Jaipur. Newai is 10 km from Banasthali.
