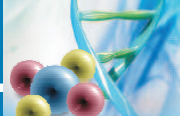

## About Banasthali University

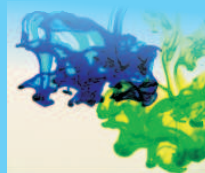
Banasthali University, accredited 'A' grade, is a fully residential institute for women and was established on October 06, 1935 by a leading educationist and visionary Pandit Hira Lal Shastri and Smt. Ratan Shastri as a school for girls. The institution has been granted the status of a deemed university in 1983 by University Grants Commission, Delhi. Thus the conference commemorates 25 years of establishment of this institution as a university.

## Call for Papers/ Posters

The scientific programme committee invites you to submit abstracts for oral and poster presentations during different sessions of the conference. The abstract must be submitted electronically/ by post to the Organizing Secretary, email: [icmbb2008@gmail.com](mailto:icmbb2008@gmail.com) not later than August 30, 2008. Prospective authors should submit an extended abstract (A4 size, text font size 12, Times New Roman, 1.5 line spacing) through email before 30th August 2008. The abstract should not exceed 500 words. The title of the abstract should be typed in font size 14. The complete postal addresses of the authors along with the email address and fax no. of the corresponding author should be provided. The name of the presenting author should be underlined. The abstract should be divided into an introduction, materials & methods, results & discussion and conclusions. Essential references may be cited and typed in Times New Roman with font size 10. The medium of all papers shall be English. It is proposed to publish proceedings of the conference containing a selected number of full papers. Full papers should be submitted before 15th September 2008.

## How to Reach

Banasthali is located 71 km from Jaipur, 8 km off on Jaipur-Kota Road. Frequent bus service is available for Banasthali University campus/ Newai from main Bus Stand (Sindhi Camp) Jaipur. Newai is 10 km from Banasthali. Conveyance will be available at Newai and Banasthali-Newai (Jaipur-Kota Broad-gauge Line) Railway Station. The nearest airport (Sanganer/Jaipur), 59 km from Banasthali is served by a number of national/ international carriers providing an extensive network.
